## **Buenaventura Announces Resumption of Operations at the Uchucchacua Mine**

LIMA, Peru--(BUSINESS WIRE)--January 30, 2019--**Compañía de Minas Buenaventura S.A.A.** (“Buenaventura” or “the Company”) (NYSE:BVN; Lima Stock Exchange: BUE.LM), Peru’s largest publicly-traded precious metals mining company, is pleased to announce that it has resumed operations at its Uchucchacua mine.

As was reported on January 11, 2019, the Contractors’ Union at Buenaventura’s Uchucchacua mine had initiated a strike on January 9, 2019. The strike lasted 21 days, during which time Buenaventura took the opportunity to perform maintenance at the operation.

While Uchucchacua’s 1Q19 production will likely be affected by the resulting production lapse, the Company is focused on offsetting the impact in subsequent quarters. Buenaventura therefore maintains its production guidance for the full year 2019, and will continue to provide relevant updates.

It is important to note that this strike was determined to be illegal by the Peruvian Labor Authority.

### **Company Description**

Compañía de Minas Buenaventura S.A.A. is Peru’s largest, publicly traded precious and base metals Company and a major holder of mining rights in Peru. The Company is engaged in the exploration, mining development, processing and trade of gold, silver and other base metals via wholly-owned mines and through its participation in joint venture projects. Buenaventura currently operates several mines in Peru (Orcopampa\*, Uchucchacua\*, Mally\*, Julcani\*, Tambomayo\*, El Brocal, La Zanja and Coimolache).

The Company owns 43.65% of Minera Yanacocha S.R.L (a partnership with Newmont Mining Corporation), an important precious metal producer and 19.58% of Sociedad Minera Cerro Verde, an important Peruvian copper producer.
